Information from Mjölby Municipality

Welcome to Mjölby Municipality. We hope you will feel welcome and safe for the time that you are with us.

Mjölby Municipality is located in the county of Östergötland in southern Sweden. It has a population of around 28,000 people. The municipality is the public body that oversees schools, elderly care, community planning, culture and leisure, amongst other responsibilities.

Applying for asylum or a residence permit

When you arrive in Sweden, it is important that you register with the Swedish Migration Agency (Sw. Migrationsverket). If you are seeking asylum or have a temporary residence permit under the Temporary Protection Directive, you are entitled to more support from community.

Ukrainian citizens may, of course, stay in Sweden for up to 90 days without seeking a permit, but this only entitles you to limited financial assistance, healthcare or help with accommodation.

Apply for a residence permit via the online service at www.migrationsverket.se or visit the Migration Agency's office in Norrköping.

If you fall ill

Region Östergötland is the body that oversees healthcare. If you become ill or need medical care in Sweden, you can find all the relevant information at www.1177.se/Ostergotland. You can also call 1177 or +46 771-11 77 00 for advice from a nurse. In the event of a serious, life-threatening illness or injury, call the emergency number 112.

Does your child need to start school?

If you want your child or children to go to a Swedish school, you need to register with the municipality's service for citizens, called Medborgarservice. You will then be contacted by the Integration department for more information.
